Community Language

Is the use of words that can be understood by *everyone*. It involves ensuring that *clear communication* is done so that everyone fully understands what has been said.

- Everyone
 - Scientific community
 - Journalists
 - PLHIV
 - Lay person.
- Therefore simplified non scientific words are needed as much as non scientific images.

The process.

- Basic HIV Cure workshop was held for 10 young people in Kampala.
- Created a WhatsApp where we held discussions on how to simplify the science and how to present it.
- Developed illustrations and animated videos to deliver the information.
- Disseminated the work on our personal social media channels which has reached;
 - Facebook 1331 views and 679 shares,
 - Instagram 719 likes,
 - Youtube 896 views
- Distributed the illustrations, animated videos in HIV clinics with youth friendly corners and held HIV Cure discussion with over 300 AYPLHIV.

Some of the terms Simplified include;

• CD4 Body soldiers

• Latency. Sleep mode

• Receptors. Cell doors

• CCR5. Open cell doors to HIV

• CCR5Δ32. Closed cell doors to HIV

Reservoir sites.
HIV hiding places

• Sanctuary sites. HIV restricted places


CCR5 AND CCR5 delta 32 illustrations.

ABOUT 1% OF THE GLOBAL POPULATION, HAVE A CHANGE (MUTATION) IN THEIR DNA THAT DOESN'T COPE FOR THE CCR5 DOOR. THEY HAPPEN TO BE NATURALLY IMMUNE TO HIV.

HIV USES A SPECIFIC POOR CALLEP CCR5, TO GET INTO A CELL


